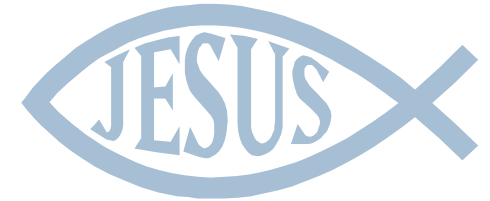

Preschool Programs



The Half-Day Preschool program provides social skill and Kindergarten readiness opportunities in a Christian environment. Three year olds meet two days a week on Tuesday and Thursday and four year olds meet three days per week on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.

Educare

Looking for a safe, friendly, Christian environment for your child while you are away at work? This Full-Day program provides a blend of preschool education and childcare for children ages 2 – 4 years old. This program is open year-round Monday thru Friday 6:00am to 6:00pm.

Latchkey

Are you looking for a safe place for your school age child before and/or after school, on snow days, and on school breaks? The Latchkey program is designed for children grades K-5. Before and after school sessions include activity periods, free play, Bible stories and homework study time. Need transportation to or from school? Our partnership with local public schools provides the necessary services to and from our location. You may drop your child off on your way to work and we will get them safely off to school. We will also be waiting for them after school. You may pick them up any time before 6:00pm.

Summer Programs

Modern playground facilities, bicycle safety training, water days, crafts, music, and more await your child. Field trips are available for school age children.
